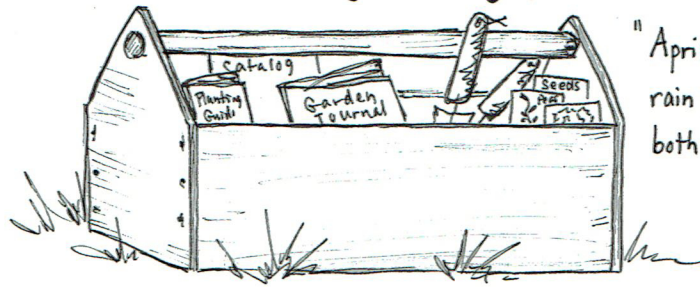
The Year's at the Spring

both together."

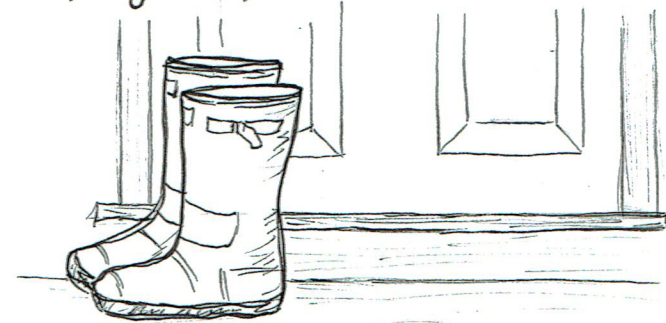
Take a walk on a rainy day. Write some thoughts about your walk in your journal. Draw a still life of your rain gear!
